

COVID CASE STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE



As we navigate the current COVID Omicron outbreak, there may be cases that start to arise in our KingsWay community. Communication with our school community, once a case is confirmed, is guided by Public Health and the Ministry of Education. Planning for the possibility of absent staff and/or students is complex and will require flexibility and patience from everyone involved in our school. This information is a step-by-step guide of what to do and who to notify should cases emerge. This information can change suddenly. You will be notified of updates on the KingsWay School Covid-19 Live Message Board.

Your child tests positive for COVID

Contact the school as soon as possible.

Self isolate for 10 days from when you tested positive. No further test is required.

Your child can return to school on Day 11 if they are asymptomatic.

A household whānau member tests positive for COVID

Complete an absentee notification on the KingsWay School App.

Isolate for 10 days and monitor for symptoms. Test on Day 3 and 10.

Your child can return to school on Day 11, if they are asymptomatic and produce a negative COVID test. Your child is a close contact of a positive case not in their house

No need to inform the school.

No isolation is required.

Monitor your child for any symptoms and get tested if unwell. Your child can continue to attend school if asymptomatic.

A household whānau member is a close contact of a positive case

No need to inform the school.

No isolation is required.

Monitor your child for any symptoms and get tested if unwell. Your child can continue to attend school if asymptomatic.

If your child is a casual (secondary) contact, they are able to attend school, but please watch for any symptoms.
