# Music Tuition Programme

## Enrolment Information

The new itinerant programme provides 30 minute small group lessons to students wishing to learn new instruments, or to support students taking Music as an elective subject. Individual lessons are still available through our private music providers. Lessons in the programme are very limited - if your student misses out we encourage undertaking lessons through our private providers.

Lessons will be held during academic class time. Music lessons are considered by the Ministry of Education as part of the curriculum and any absences from class time must be excused. It may be possible for a lesson time to be re-scheduled to avoid clashing with assessments or class trips. Lessons will be scheduled on a rotating timetable to avoid missing too much of the same classes.

These lessons are specifically for Year 7 - 13 students. Students Year 6 and under who are interested in learning a musical instrument are encouraged to undertake lessons through our private providers who also tutor from the Junior Campus. To sign up please follow link:

## Fees and Conditions

### Terms of Enrolment

Students are expected to participate in lessons for the full year.

### Payment

- Music lessons - free of charge
- Administration fee (non-refundable annual charge) - \$50
- Instrument Hireage, please see below

(Please note, private lesson fees will differ from itinerant fees)

### Lessons missed by students

Students who miss three or more lessons in a row without valid reason will forfeit their lessons with no refund as this is an administration fee. Students wishing to withdraw from lessons will need parental notice four weeks in advance.

If a student is unable to attend a lesson for any reason (such as illness, a school trip, exams, etc.) the teacher must be notified directly by 7am on the day. Lessons missed by students will not be made up.
